Centennial Regatta: All Fleets

The Centennial Regatta on **Saturday** (tomorrow) will have starts for Atlantics, Cruising Class, 12s, 420s, and Optis. All fleets will share the same starting area at the inner starting area (the one typically used for 12s and Lasers), but each fleet will have a different course, which will be announced in the start area.

Atlantics, Cruising Class and 12s should monitor channel 68 at all times. 420s and Optis will be hailed with a bullhorn.

There will not be a skippers meeting. The existing sailing instructions for each fleet will apply. The starting sequence will be:

13:54 — Atlantics Alert Signal

13:55 — Atlantics Warning Signal

13:56 — Atlantics Preparatory Signal

13:59 — Atlantics One Minute Signal and Cruising Class Alert Signal

14:00 — Atlantics Start Signal and Cruising Class Warning Signal

14:01 — Cruising Class Preparatory Signal

14:04 — Cruising Class One Minute Signal and 12s Alert Signal

14:05 — Cruising Class Start Signal and 12s Warning Signal

14:06 — 12s Preparatory Signal

14:09 — 12s One Minute Signal

14:10 — 12s Start Signal and one minute before 420s 3 minute sequence begins

14:11 — 420s three-minute warning and subsequent signals using their usual audible starting sequence

14:14 — 420s Start and one minute before Opti 3 minute sequence begins

14:15 — Optis three-minute warning and subsequent signals using their usual audible starting sequence

14:18 — Optis Start

All fleets are asked to keep the relative experience of other fleets in mind in the starting area and when they meet on the course.

All sailors are also reminded that a boat sailing towards the pre-start side of the starting line or one of its extensions after her starting signal because she was over early shall keep clear of any boat not doing so, *regardless of what fleet they are in* (rule 21.1).
