This is a service offered to all members.

How it works:

Place your order in the store before 3:00 pm and the item will arrive around 9:00 am the next business day, *as long as it is in stock*. All orders would need to be placed through the store. The store behind the clubhouse. Kelly is happy to do this via email (followed up by a call), phone, or in person. There is a Hamilton catalog in the store if needed.

The items do not cost the member more than what the parts are priced at in the catalog. There is no surcharge for the delivery from Hamilton, as they are giving the club a small discount for having one ordering location. It makes it easier for Hamilton as well as convenient for our Club.

The Hamilton order will be placed and once arrived, you can charge it to your account or pay by credit card, apple pay, or google pay.
